WHO WE ARE

On the afternoon of August 4, 2001, a tragic event changed our community forever. A well-known Medicine Hat physician and his family were traveling on Highway 41 South when they were involved in a devastating motor vehicle collision. Despite the best efforts of emergency responders, the doctor passed away at the scene. The heartbreaking reality that no Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) was close enough to make a difference sparked an outcry—and from that pain, HALO Air Ambulance was born.

HALO Air Ambulance is Southern Alberta's only dedicated HEMS program. Since our first mission in 2007, HALO has flown thousands of life-saving missions; reaching critically ill and injured patients in their greatest time of need. Strategically based in Medicine Hat, HALO improves response times to remote and inaccessible areas, delivering critical medical care when every second counts.

Partnering with regional and provincial stakeholders, HALO responds to emergency medical scene calls, inter-facility patient transfers, search and rescue operations, fire rescue, law enforcement support, and disaster responses. Every mission we fly is powered by the generosity of our supporters, and every life we impact is a testament to what we can achieve when a community comes together.



THE IMPACT

In Southern Alberta, where vast rural landscapes stretch for miles, HALO Air Ambulance stands as a promise: no one is alone in their time of need. For the Dorohoy family, that promise became a reality on a day that changed everything. A devastating horse accident left Christine in a race against time, where ground help was hours away. HALO became their lifeline, a helicopter on the horizon delivering hope and survival.

"We wouldn't be telling this story today without HALO," a family member shares. In critical moments, HALO's dedicated team and quick response can mean the difference between life and death.

As Southern Alberta's only dedicated helicopter emergency service, HALO relies on community support to keep flying. Every flight is made possible by generous donors, ensuring families like the Dorohoy's have a second chance.

HALO Air Ambulance is more than a service; it's a lifeline when minutes matter most. For those who support HALO, you aren't just giving – you're saving lives.

Register Your Event

Complete the Event Registration Form (attached or available online at HALO's website) to let us know about your event.

This step ensures we can support you and maintain alignment with HALO's mission.

HALO FUNDRAISERS V5. FUNDRAISERS FOR HALO

HALO Fundraisers

These are official events organized by HALO, such as Turf to Tarmac, Charity Golf Tournament, and the Dinner & Auction. HALO manages all planning, sponsorships, and donations, with funds going directly to operations.



Fundraisers for HALO

These are independently organized events where the proceeds benefit HALO. Examples include businesses donating a portion of sales or community-hosted auctions. While HALO is the beneficiary, we are not involved in planning or fundraising efforts.

Why This Matters

Since multiple groups may fundraise for HALO at the same time, businesses might feel they are being asked repeatedly.

To prevent confusion:

- * Clearly state your event is a fundraiser for HALO, not a HALO-hosted fundraiser.
- Use the Donation Tracking Sheet to help avoid duplicate requests.
- **#** If questions arise, HALO is happy to provide guidance.

BUILD AN EVENT COMMITTEE

Creating a committee will help ensure you have the support and expertise needed to plan a successful event. When selecting committee members, consider their commitment levels, skill sets, and community connections.

Key Roles may include:

***** Event Chairperson

The leader of your event planning committee. This role oversees the overall planning process, provides direction to volunteers, and makes decisions regarding the event. The chairperson also serves as the spokesperson, updating the team on progress and serving as the main contact with HALO.

***** Marketing and Promotions Lead

Responsible for all promotional needs, including social media, posters, and outreach. This person should have excellent written communication skills, be organized, and have a good understanding of social media platforms.

* Sponsorship Lead

Manages sponsorships for your event, including outreach to businesses, implementing sponsorship benefits, and ensuring recognition for sponsors. This person should be comfortable speaking to community members and business leaders to secure support.

* Volunteer Lead

Oversees all volunteer needs, from recruitment to training and on-site coordination. This role ensures volunteers know their responsibilities and feel appreciated throughout the event.

Building a strong team will ensure the workload is manageable, tasks are well organized, and your event is set up for success.

RAFFLE5

Adding a raffle is a great way to boost fundraising and engagement at your event while supporting HALO Air Ambulance. it's important to understand when a raffle license is required and how to stay compliant with Alberta Gaming, Liquor & Cannabis (AGLC) regulations.

When Do You Need a Raffle License?

A raffle requires an AGLC license if it involves all three elements:

Money - Participants pay to enter.

Chance – The winner is determined randomly.

Prize – A reward is given to the winner.

Popular Ticket Types

One-Day Raffle

Uses double tear tickets; winner must be present.

Multi-Day Raffle

Uses printed tickets with AGLC-required details; winner does not need to be present.

Multiple Ticket Prices

Must use different colors or series numbers.

Popular Ticket Pricing Options:

Option #1: 1 ticket for \$5

Option #2: 1 for \$5, 5 for \$5

Option #3: 1 for \$5, 10 for \$20

Option #4: 1 for \$5, 3 for \$10, 10 for \$20

Posters

Design eye-catching posters and display them in high-traffic areas like coffee shops, community centers, gyms, and local businesses.



Newspapers

Submit a press release or event details to your local newspaper's community events section.



Email Invitations

Send personalized invitations to friends, family, colleagues, and community members.



Radio/TV Stations

Reach out to local stations to request event mentions or interviews. Community stations often support charitable initiatives.



Social Media

- Create an event page or post on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter/X and LinkedIn.
- Use hashtags like #inflightforyourlife and #HALOAirAmbulance.

Accepting Donations

Donations can be made directly to HALO via cash, cheque, e-transfer or online. Keep records of all donations, including donor names, addresses and amounts.



Tax Receipts

HALO can issue tax receipts for eligible donations of \$25 or more. Please ensure donor details are accurately recorded and submitted with the proceeds.



Submitting Funds

It is reccommended that all funds be sumbitted to HALO winith 30 days of your event.

Steer clear of

- Using HALO's logo or name without permission.
- Incurring expenses expecting reimbursement from HALO.
- Hosting events involving illegal or unethical activities.

To ensure an organized and efficient approach to requesting support, we've included records, you can avoid duplication, maintain positive relationships with supporters, a Solicitation Tracking Sheet in this toolkit. This tool helps event organizers track approached multiple times for HALO-related fundraisers. By keeping detailed businesses contacted, donations received, and ensures businesses aren't and provide a clear overview of your efforts.

How to Use the Solicitation Tracking Sheet

- 1. Log every business or individual you contact, even if they decline or do not respond.
- 2. Record key details about the donation (e.g., type, value) and the date received.
- 3. Share this tracking sheet with HALO or other event organizers upon request to help maintain clear communication and coordination.
